PROMOTERS CONDITIONS

1. The Meet will be held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules, and has been licensed Level 1 (number) by the ASA for entry into District and National Championships and Competitions.
2. All entries must be made on the understanding that the promoter's conditions are accepted.
3. All Competitors must be members of an affiliated club, registered with the ASA, and may compete in the name of one club only. It is important that swimmers enter under the exact name by which they are known to the ASA, so that our computer software identifies the correct swimmers. Entering electronically is therefore recommended.
4. The promoters reserve the right to accept or reject entries at their discretion, and to restrict entries in order that the Meet may be completed within the time available. If the Meet is oversubscribed, Entries will be accepted on **"quickest times submitted by age group basis"** and must meet the set qualifying times. But will ensure an equal balance of swimmers across the age groups. A list of rejected swimmers and refund cheque will be sent, Incorrect or incomplete entries will be rejected and entry fees will not be refunded. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the closing date.
5. Age Groups will be 9yrs, for 200 events only. 10yrs for 50, 200 & 400 events. The rest of age groups 11/12yr, 13/14yrs, 15/over are for all events. Awards for top three in each age group. **Ages at 5th December 2010**
6. Events 1 & 2 will be run as a mixed boys & Girls event. All other events will remain the same, ie boys & girls.
7. Entry times **MUST** be those for a 50m pool, conversion accepted.
8. Entries of 10 or more swimmers from the same club **MUST** be made electronically; Entries of 9 or less swimmers from the same club may be made using the official meet entry form. Unless arranged and agreed in advance with the Meet Manager, Entries must reach the Meet Secretary on or before midnight on **1st November 2010**. No late entries will be accepted.
9. Entry fees are £5.00 per 50m or all four £15.00, £6.00 per 100m, 200m, & 400m, £8 per 800m and 1500m and include the levy per accepted entry made by the ASA for licensed events. Coaches passes (maximum 4 per club) are £10.00 each and include a program per pass and one full set of results per club only if requested at sign in. One free coach's pass will be given for each 15 swimmers that attend from individual clubs. Entry fees should be paid on **one** consolidated cheque, made payable to **TEAM BATH YOUTH & AGE GROUP SWIM CLUB**.
10. Entries and results for this Meet will be held on computer. As required by the Data Protection Act 1998 submission of entries implies consent to the holding of personal information on computer. These details may be made public before, during or after the Meet.
11. There will be no entry cards for this Meet. Swimmers must register on the day at least 30 minutes before the start of each Session. Swimmers withdrawing from an event without prior notification after they have registered may be deemed to have withdrawn from the rest of the Meet. Swimmers who register late will be allocated any vacant lanes in the slowest heat. If no such lanes are available, the swimmer will not be allowed to swim.
12. Entries will be seeded into heats based on entry times; the slowest heats will be swum first.
13. Swimmers must report to the competitor's steward's eight heats prior to their own.
14. Only swimmers reporting for their event and officials will be allowed on poolside during the Meet, Coaches in possession of a coach pass are allowed on poolside during warm ups. Wet swimmers are not allowed in the spectator area.

15. All events will be HDW. Awards will be made for the top three in each age group 9yrs, 10yrs, 11/12yrs, 13/14yrs and 15 over.
16. In line with child protection policies, any person wishing to use video or photographic equipment (including mobile phones with photographic facility) are required to sign the authorization book available at the entry desk and must display a camera pass. Any person not complying will be asked to leave the pool complex.
17. Neither the promoters nor Bath University accept any liability for any loss or damage to personal belongings.
18. The promoters reserve the right to alter these conditions if necessary, any alterations, being announced during the Meet, any matter not covered by these conditions shall be at the promoter's discretion if not covered by ASA Laws or Technical Rules.
